There is a parent meeting this same night as well. Inform your parents that the meeting will be at 9:00 pm in the Learning Commons/Media Center. They should attend so they can receive information about your, and their, participation in the production.

REMEMBER

Each participating student must pay a \$75 Participation fee for this show. **In February** you will be sent information on how to pay, as well as how to order show items you might wish to buy. Fees are DUE on February 10, 2025.

If you have not already done so this season, you and your parent **MUST** sign **BOTH** the Expectation and Permission forms **ONLINE** before this meeting.

Remember to wear or bring a **PLAIN BLACK SHIRT** for your headshot if you did not already have one taken in the Fall/Winter of 2024.

We will be using an online scheduling and communication platform called Virtual Callboard to organize schedules and information for these productions: **www.andersontheatre.vcallboard.com**. If you do not already have an account with VCB, contact Mrs. Seeley as soon as possible to be added (Quartermoon@earthlink.net). You need to enter all conflicts in your account by January 31, 2025; once you are scheduled for a rehearsal or work day, you will **NOT** be allowed a conflict without permission from the Directors. More info about VCB will be shared at the First Rehearsal meeting.
